INTRODUCTION

Global terrorism is on the rise and Singapore is facing our highest level of terror threat in recent years. A terror attack is not a matter of if but when, and we cannot afford to remain complacent. The Home Team has been stepping up our fight against terrorism and more resources have been committed to strengthening our security forces. But the Government's effort alone is not enough. To safeguard our way of life, everyone must play our part. The SGSecure national movement is Singapore's community response to the threat of terror. It aims to sensitise, train, and mobilise our community to prevent and deal with a terror attack.

OBJECTIVES

This workshop aims to equip participants with the following skills, to enable the participants to be SGSecure Prepared Citizens:

- Understand the seriousness of the terror threat and the actions required of a prepared citizen.
- Acquire the knowledge on:

 - ✓ The skills necessary to **help one another bounce back** from an attack; and
 - ✓ Functions of **SGSecure app (Terrorism Activities Reporting)** and the embedded **SGSecure e-Learning feature**;

 - ✓ Functions of **myResponder app (First-aid & Fire Incidents Reporting)**
